
### **ASSEMBLY:**


#### **MULTI-USE NOZZLE**


- 1. Slide fully charged battery onto the bottom of the handle of your HyrdoJet X5 until you hear it click in place.
- 2. To use with Multi-Use Nozzle, insert small end of nozzle into HydroJet X5, and turn clockwise until locked in place. See Fig.1 + 2
- 3. Choose desired setting by turning the end of the nozzle until your chosen setting lines up with the arrow on the nozzle. See Fig. 3


## METAL EXTENSION ROD – FOR USE WITH JET SPRAY NOZZLE AND FLAT SPRAY NOZZLE


- 1. Slide fully charged battery onto the bottom of the handle of your HyrdoJet X5 until you hear it click in place.
- 2. To use with Metal Rod Extension, insert plastic end of rod into HydroJet X5, and turn clockwise until locked in place. See Fig. 1
- 3. Pull pack brass collar on end of the extension rod, and insert the Jet Spray nozzle or Flat Spray nozzle, then allow collar to spring back into place to lock. See Fig. 5











### **HOW TO USE:**

#### **CAR WASH SOAP BOTTLE**


- 1. Slide fully charged battery onto the bottom of the handle of your HyrdoJet X5 until you hear it click in place.
- 2. To use with Car Wash Soap Bottle, insert small end of the bottle into HydroJet X5, and turn clockwise until locked in place. See Fig. 1
- 3. Fill bottle with amount of soap per manufacturer's recommendation.


#### **USING WITH GARDEN HOSE**


- 1. To use with a standard USA Garden Hose, assemble HydroJet X5 based on ASSEMBLY instructions.
- Then, find the USA Garden Hose Quick connect adapter, slide the collar down, and attach to the bottom connection point on the HydroJet X5, allowing collar to spring back and lock into place. See Fig. 7
- 3. Screw your garden hose into the Quick Connect adapter, and turn water on.
- When ready, choose HIGH OR LOW setting by using the Power Button and point HydroJet X5 at intended surface. Pull the trigger and spray until done. See Fig.8


#### **USING WITH A BUCKET**


- 1. To use with a water bucket, assemble HydroJet X5 based on ASSEMBLY instructions.
- 2. Then, find the 3/8" supply hose connect, slide the collar down, and attach to the bottom connection point on the HydroJet X5, allowing collar to spring back and lock into place. See Fig. 9
- 3. Unscrew the Hose Assembly piece (cone shaped piece) and set aside. Attach one end of the supply hose over the end, and slide the Hose Assembly piece through the hose, and screw back into place. See Fig.10
- 4. Attach the other end of the hose to the water filter, and place water filter into a water bucket. See Fig.11
- 5. When ready, choose HIGH OR LOW setting by using the Power Button and point HydroJet X5 at intended surface. Pull the trigger and spray until done. See Fig.8















### **CHARGING BATTERY**

- 1. Remove battery pack from the pressure washer
- 2. Plug included power adapter into an indoor standard wall outlet
- 3. Plug the other end into the charging port located on the battery, as seen in Fig. 12
- 4. When charging, indicator light will remain solid RED. When fully charged, indicator light will change to solid GREEN.



### **STORAGE**

When done, allow all parts to air dry before putting away. When dry, place all components back in their designated spot in the hard case. Store in a cool, dry place until ready to use again.

### **WARNINGS**

# When using this product basic precautions should always be followed, including the following:
